

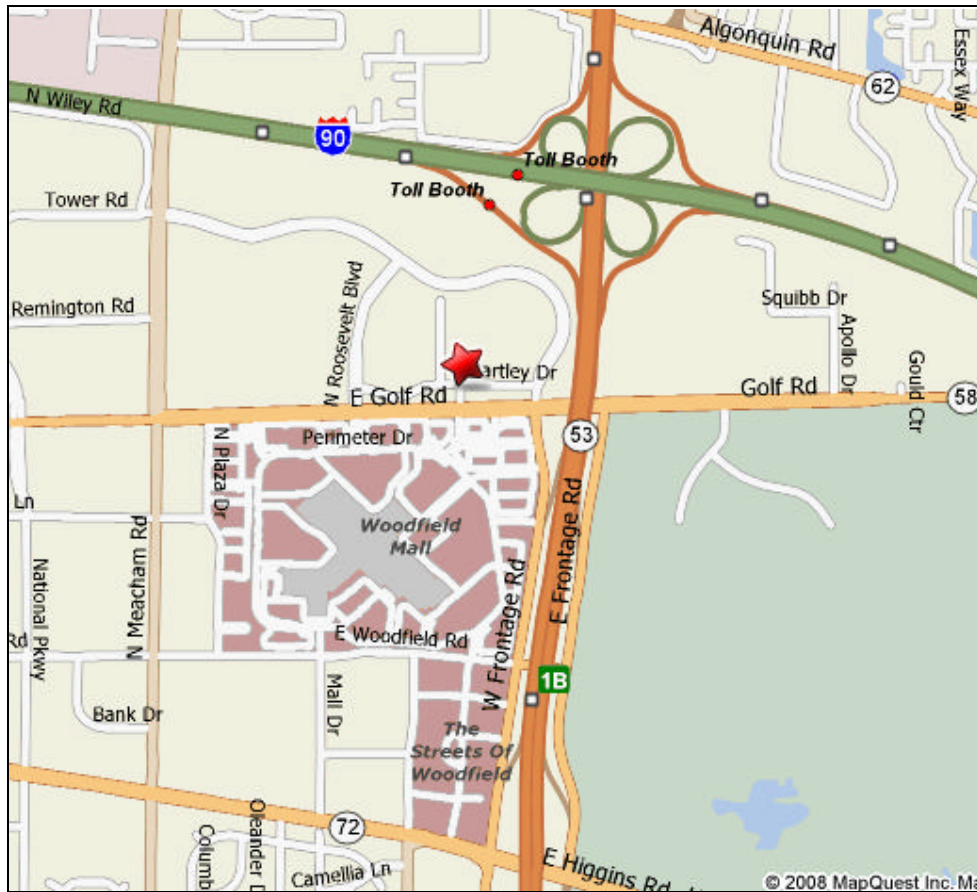
# Getting to the Hyatt Regency Woodfield

## IF ARRIVING BY CAR:

### Directions from O'HARE International Airport (9 miles) and POINTS EAST:

Take I-90 West to Ill. 53 South (Schaumburg). Exit at Woodfield Rd. Turn left at first traffic signal. Turn left at next signal on Frontage Rd. Turn left on Golf Rd. Hotel is 2 blocks on right. Free self-parking is available.

**If you are arriving from the WEST:**

Take I-90 East to I-290/Ill. 53 South. Exit at Woodfield Rd. Turn left at first traffic signal. Turn left at next signal on Frontage Rd. Turn left on Golf Rd. Hotel is 2 blocks on right.

**If you are arriving from the SOUTH:**

Take I-294 North (toll road) to I-290 West; continue on I-290 for 15 miles. Exit at Higgins Rd/IL-72 (exit 1B) toward IL-58/Golf Road/Woodfield Road. Proceed 0.4 miles, then merge onto E Frontage Rd. After 1 mile, turn left onto Golf Rd/IL-58 West. Turn right on East Drive for Hotel.

**IF ARRIVING BY AIR:**

**O'Hare International Airport**, nine miles from the Hyatt, is serviced by all major US carriers and many international carriers. See <http://www.flychicago.com/ohare/aboutOHare/airlinesOhare.shtml> for a complete list.

The Hyatt Regency Woodfield does not offer a free airport shuttle. Transportation options to/from O'Hare are listed below.

**GO Airport Express** offers shuttles to Schaumburg hotels, including the Hyatt Regency Woodfield. Current rates (add \$1/person departure tax): \$20/one passenger, \$25/pair, \$30/three, \$10/each additional. Airport Express ticket counters at O'Hare Airport can be found on the baggage claim level in each terminal: Terminal 1 (door 1E), Terminal 2 (door 2D), Terminal 3 (door 3E) and Terminal 5 (door 5D). **Taxi service** from Chicago O'Hare International Airport is available at all terminals from the lower level curbside (outside the Baggage Claim areas). Current estimated rates are as follows.

All-Star Cab and Shuttle: \$24.00 for up to 4 travelers. Use the All-Star Cab courtesy phones located on the Hotel /Transportation Computer Kiosks in the baggage claim area in all terminals, or call (888) 533-4240 after picking up luggage at O'Hare.

American Taxi: \$31.50 for up to 4 travelers. Call (847) 253-4411 after picking up luggage at O'Hare.

**LOCAL ATTRACTIONS:**

Schaumburg, Illinois, is the retail commercial hub of the northwest suburbs, located approximately thirty miles from downtown Chicago. If you have extra time in the Schaumburg area, here are some local attractions of interest.

**Medieval Times Dinner and Tournament.** The Schaumburg Castle is located at the intersection of I-90 and Roselle Rd (2001 N. Roselle Road, Schaumburg, IL) . Tickets (\$57.95/adult + tax) include dinner and a show, in which six knights, donning authentic medieval armor, clash in a medieval jousting tournament for the title of King's Champion. The **Woodfield Mall**, the Chicago area's largest shopping center, is located across the street from the Hyatt Regency Woodfield. Free shuttles are available to the mall entrance from the Hyatt. For details: <http://www.shopwoodfield.com>

Also nearby are the **Streets of Woodfield** an outdoor specialty shopping center with a mix of urban street-front shops, restaurants, and a 20-screen theater. A free trolley service operates between the mall, the Streets of Woodfield, and other Woodfield-area locations; see <http://www.ci.schaumburg.il.us/vos.nsf/schaumburg/trolley> for schedules and stops.

The **Spring Valley Nature Sanctuary** (1111 E Schaumburg Rd, Schaumburg) has 135 acres of fields, forests, marshes and streams. Spring Valley also features over three miles of handicapped-accessible hiking trails . Free admission.

Also on site is the **Volkening Heritage Farm**, a living history museum demonstrating what life was like in an 1880s German farm community. Authentically dressed interpreters welcome and guide visitors through the site. For details: <http://www.parkfun.com/recreation/SpringValley.aspx>
